Pastor's Paragraph

"In every way, speak and act as people who will be judged by the law of freedom." – James 2:12

Angry words.

The airwaves, news and social media are filled with angry words. No matter what topic, it seems like there's always someone who is ready to jump in and give their opposing opinion. We've become adept at monologues, the long and somewhat tedious speeches that used to be relegated to Shakespeare's plays.

Rather than healthy conversation where we listen carefully so we can learn from another, it seems like we're participating in "parallel monologues." In other words, I'm listening to you only long enough to figure out how to rebut what you're saying and so I can turn the conversation back to what I want to say.

That isn't healthy conversation.

James warns us, *"With our tongues we bless God; with the same tongues we curse the very men and women made in God's image"* (James 3:7). James also tells us that we'll have more luck taming a tiger than taming our tongue.

What are we to do?

There's another way. We can start by listening first. Let's ask the other person to tell their story. Then we can tell our story. Let's understand each other's fears, frustrations and anxieties. When we know how we came to be where we are, we have a much better chance to find common ground, work together and find unity. Anger will be distant.

That's the way of love. It's the way to be right with God. And it's a great way to be free of the influence of angry words.
