Psalm 145.4

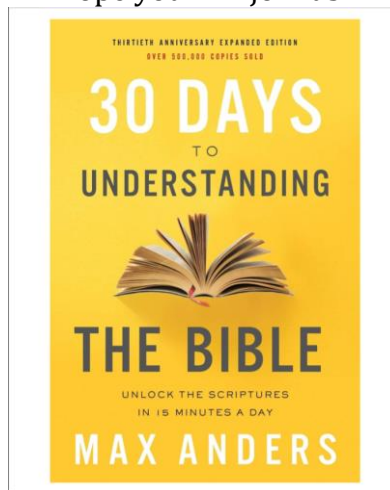

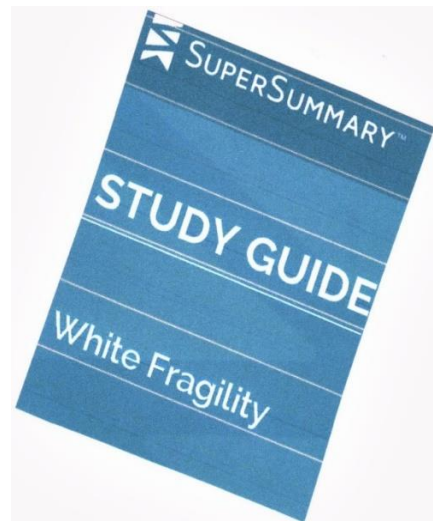
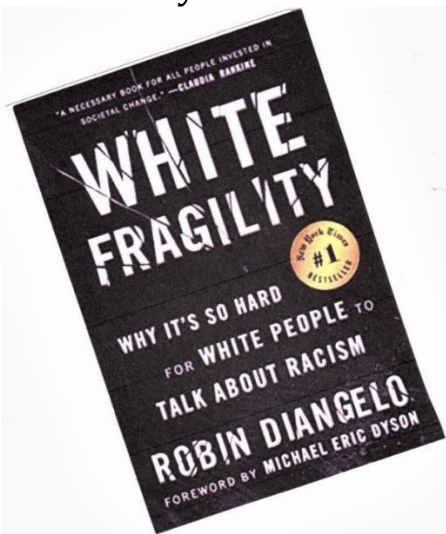

Mozart Adevu Missionary in Ghana Corona UMC Outreach

Three years ago, on December 17, 2017, Mozart Adevu spoke at our church about his missionary work in Ghana. We at Corona UMC made a commitment to support his work. He had planned to be in the US this year to speak at supporting churches, but Covid-19 changed that plan. His work focuses on the training in crop and pest control, improving nutrition by using moringa and soybeans, beekeeping, animal husbandry. Malnutrition especially for women and children had been a big problem. With the introduction of the high protein nutrient rich Moringa plant the malnutrition rate has been greatly reduced. In his latest Newsletter he spoke about organizing an 18-week farmer field school that trained 100 farmers in organic agriculture. This included learning about organic pesticides and fertilizers on the crops which produces safe food. If you would like to support his continued work, send a check to the church and indicate it is for Mozart's work in Ghana. We would like to collect this money during the month so one check from our church would be sent. Any amount will help our global neighbors. Mozart says "God's mission of feeding the hungry and the poor has been the hallmark of his work."
