The Mission Sunday service, September 25 at 10:00 a.m.*

We honor those who work at Settlement House to feed the hungry and operate the secondhand store. We thank our congregation for donating food and packing lunches for the homeless. We have been in partnership with the Settlement House for many years under the guidance of the late Sally Carlson, a tireless servant to help the disadvantaged of Corona/Norco.

Our church has selected schools to support the students with school supplies, Christmas gifts, and in other ways the school asks us to help. This year we delivered a full carload of school supplies to Coronita Elementary School. They were very appreciative. In addition to the above our church helps support our Missionary, Katherine Parker, for her work in Nepal.

At our Sunday service you will get to meet Karen Roper, manager for Corona Homeless Solutions. She has a wealth of experience after working for Orange County for 35 years as the Director of Housing & Community Services.

You will learn of the comprehensive systems-oriented plan developed for our communities. The plan has reduced homelessness by 33% since 2019. The Harrison House Emergency Shelter/Navigation Center, which will open in 2023, will have 40 transitional housing units for individuals who will progress to permanent housing. It will provide medical, dental, mental health & life skills to participants. The Ayres Hotel will have 53 rooms for disabled homeless who cannot live independently but who will benefit from wrap around services. In addition, plans are for 110 families to have affordable housing.

Make It Cozy is in partnership to help those who move into permanent housing to have the basic furniture, appliances and move in supplies to make it a home. As a church we will have opportunities to become helpful by providing items for permanent housing and to make meals at Harrison Center.

Cheryl Lum will speak about what God wants us to do and our United Methodist values.

Why do we Serve? Because God loves us, and Jesus showed us how to be compassionate. Lord, when did we give you food to eat, clothes to wear, or showed you hospitality? “When you did it for one of the least of these, you did it to me.”
